How to prepare for success? (Technically)



Early:

- Introduce unit tests
- Add flexibility
- Commit to a single style

Short Term:

- Start re-paying your technical debt
- Introduce integration tests

Long Term:

- Introduce end-to-end and contract tests

How to prepare for success? (Otherwise)



Early:

- Trusted circle of professionals
- Make them work together
- Adopt agile methodology

Short Term:

- Introduce code reviews

Long Term:

- Introduce post-mortem

And if you are already successful?



ASAP:

- Introduce end-to-end tests
- Treat code as legacy
- Agile (NO full rewrite)

Short Term:

- Start incremental refactoring
- Define target architecture and stages
